The 1st International Symposium on Chemical and Biomedical Imaging and the editorial board meeting of the journal *Chemical and Biomedical Imaging* will take place on August 16-18, 2024 in Nanjing, China. The symposium is co-organized by the School of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering at Nanjing University and ACS Publications and is supported by the State Key Laboratory of Coordination Chemistry, the State Key Laboratory of Analytical Chemistry for Life Science, the Chemistry and Biomedicine Innovation Center at Nanjing University, and the Jiangsu Society of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering.

With the theme "Exploring the Frontier: Innovations in Chemical & Biomedical Imaging", the symposium aims to foster valuable interactions among global scientists through the discussion about cutting-edge research, technological advances, and future directions. Topics include but not limited to new methods and applications of chemical imaging, single-molecule and super-resolution imaging, single particle and interface imaging, imaging probes and contrast agents, applications of biomedical imaging, innovation in chemical imaging instrumentation and AI- assisted diagnostic imaging. The conference program includes a diverse range of distinguished leaders from institutions and organizations worldwide, concentrating on the latest developments in the field.

The symposium will be an offline event spanning three days, and will feature plenary lectures, forums, poster presentations, and the editorial board meeting of the journal *Chemical and Biomedical Imaging*, which will be held in a hybrid format allowing for both online and in-person attendance.

The conference does not provide transportation services. Attendees are kindly requested to make their own arrangements to reach the registration venue (Lobby of Nanjing International Conference Center, adjacent to the East Gate of Xianlin Campus, Nanjing University):

1. International Airport - Nanjing University Xianlin Campus:

(1) Taxi: Approximately 200 RMB per car, about 60 kilometers, takes approximately 1 hour.


(2) Subway: Take subway line S1 (towards Nanjing South Station) from Lukou Airport Station at Terminal 2 of Nanjing Lukou International Airport. Transfer to subway line 3 (towards Linchang) at Nanjing South Station, then transfer again to subway line 2 (towards Jiangtian Road) at Daxinggong Station. Get off at Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station. Take bus route 321 from Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station and alight at Xianlin NU East Gate Station (or walk approximately 1 kilometer to the NU International Conference Centre next to the East Gate of Nanjing University Xianlin Campus). The fare is approximately 10-12 RMB per

person, and the journey takes about 2 hours.



2. Nanjing Station - Nanjing University Xianlin Campus:

(1) Taxi: Approximately 55 RMB per car, about 20 kilometers, takes approximately 35 minutes.

(2) Subway: Take subway line 3 (towards Mozhou East Road) from Nanjing Station, then transfer to subway line 2 (towards Jiangtian Road) at Daxinggong Station. Get off at Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station. Take bus route 321 from Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station and alight at Xianlin NU East Gate Station (or walk approximately 1 kilometer to the NU International Conference Centre next to the East Gate of Nanjing University Xianlin Campus). The fare is approximately 6-8 RMB per person, and the journey takes about 1 hour and 10 minutes.

3. Nanjing South Station - Nanjing University Xianlin Campus:

(1) Taxi: Approximately 70-100 RMB per car, about 30-40 kilometers, takes approximately 40 minutes.

(2) Subway: Take subway line 3 (towards Linchang) from Nanjing South Station, then transfer to subway line2 (towards Jiangtian Road) at Daxinggong Station. Get off at Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station. Takebus route 321 from Nanjing University Xianlin Campus Station and alight at Xianlin NU East Gate Station (or





walk approximately 1 kilometer to the NU International Conference Centre next to the

East Gate of Nanjing University Xianlin Campus). The fare is approximately 7-9 RMB per person, and the journey takes about 1 hour and 15 minutes.
